

A welcome speech at the opening ceremony of an outdoor sports camp

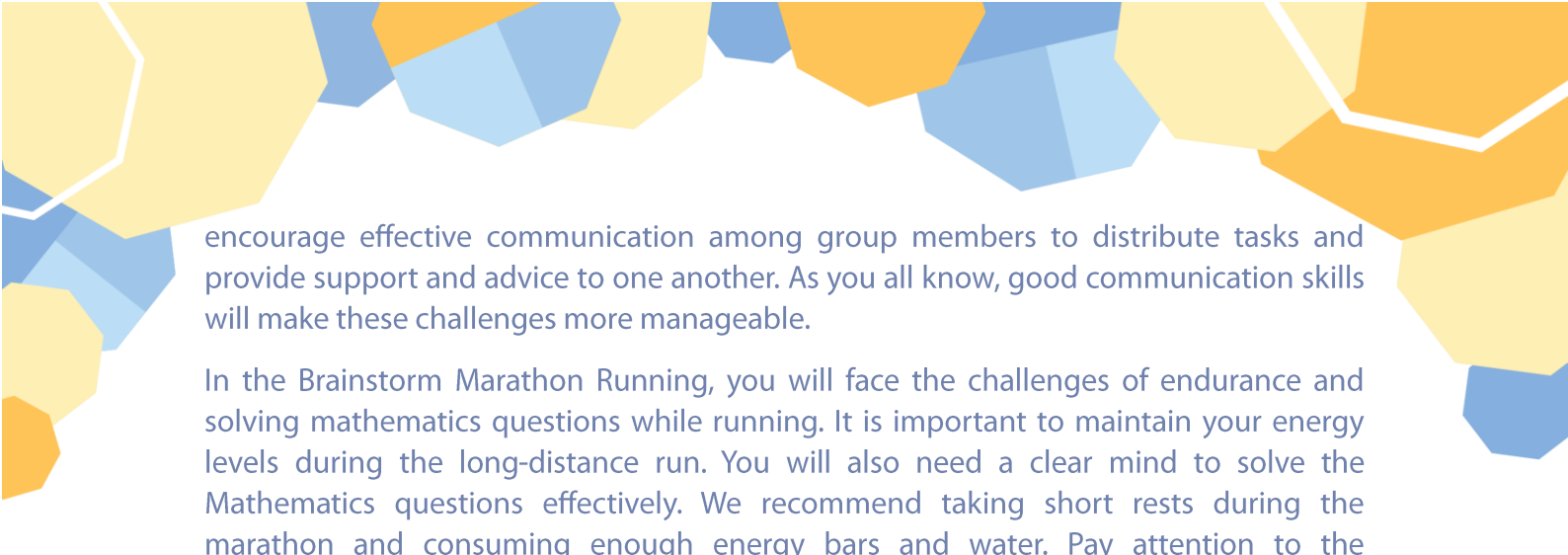
